## **OVERVIEW**



The home of FC Bayern Basketball was initially built for the Olympic Games in 1972 to host the basketball competitions. The arena was named after Rudi Sedlmayer, who was the president of the Bavarian Sports Association at that time, as well as a member of the Munich Olympic Games Organizing Committee.



## **OVERVIEW**



Across the 80s and 90s the arena has been used as a music show venue (e.g. Eurovision Song Contest 1983), to host trade fairs and boxing matches (amongst others: Vladimir and Vitali Klitschko). The arena has also been the venue of international Handball and Volleyball tournaments.



## **OVERVIEW**



In April 2011, the City of Munich has agreed to allow the use of the arena as a Basketball court. After that, the once Rudi Sedlmayer Sporthalle has been extensively renovated, in cooperation with the new naming right holder *Audi*, in order to make it suitable for the hosting of national and international basketball events. Since the 2011/2012 season, the arena changed its name to Audi Dome. The Audi Dome has currently a capacitiy of 6.500 spectators.








## **AUDI DOME**

- Various hospitality areas and dressing rooms





- Independent access/entrance





- Independent access/entrance





The Audi Dome is located in the South-West of the city centre of Munich. It is served by multiple public transportation, and located nearby the Mittleren Ring, with immediate access to the Autobahn A96 as well as all other directions.


