## HYGIENE AND CONDUCT GUIDELINES



**PLEASE BE SURE TO OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS**

In case of violation inside or outside the Allianz Arena, access to / stay in the Allianz Arena may be denied.

- **Admission** is possible only with one of the following proofs. This evidence should ideally be in digital form (app or digital proof of vaccination with QR code) at the entrance. Please have your proofs ready at the Security Check to avoid queues.

- **Negative corona test**

- PCR test not older than **48** hours before kick-off
- An antigen test is not valid!

Children do not need testing in the following cases:

- Children up to their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday
- Pupils older than 12 who are subject to regular testing as part of school attendance (also valid during school holidays)

- **Proof of complete vaccination**

- For approved vaccines see [www.pei.de/impfstoffe/covid-19](http://www.pei.de/impfstoffe/covid-19)
- at least 14 days must have passed since the last vaccination
- Convalescent persons with single vaccination from the day of the administered dose are also considered vaccinated

- **Convalescents**

- with positive PCR test at least 28 days as well as maximum 6 months ago

**NEW:** The "3G plus" verification must be done together with an identity verification. Therefore, please make sure to carry your identity card or passport with you.

**Despite "3G plus", we still recommend the following behavioural measures:**



**KEEP DISTANCE -  
MINIMUM 1,5 METERS**



**COUGH INTO YOUR ELBOW**



**WEAR A FACE COVERING**



**KEEP HANDS AWAY FROM FACE**



**AVOID SHAKING HANDS**



**WASH YOUR HANDS REGULARLY

**AVOID CROWDS**



**DISINFECT YOUR HANDS**

- Arrive early to the Allianz Arena to avoid close contact. Please observe the specified stadium opening hours and recommended admission information.
- Please notice that bags as well as rucksacks larger than DIN A 4 format are not allowed inside Allianz Arena.
- Payment is still cashless via Apple Pay or EC / credit card.
- If possible, please remain in your allocated seat before and during the match.
- Practice good hand hygiene, use hand sanitizer (sanitizer dispensers are available) and avoid touching your face as well as surfaces (handles, railings etc.) whenever possible.

Admission and/or permission to remain will be denied in particular if a visitor

- is suffering from symptoms that could indicate an infection with coronavirus (typical symptoms of COVID-19 infection: dry cough, fever, shortness of breath, headache, sore throat, aching limbs and impaired sense of taste and smell).
- has received evidence of SARS-CoV-2 infection.
- is subject to a quarantine measure.

Despite all the protective and hygienic measures, the risk of infection of coronavirus when visiting the Allianz Arena cannot be completely ruled out. Every ticket holder and visitor to a match should be aware of this risk. We also refer you to the risk groups defined by the Robert Koch Institute.

In the event of a demonstrable infection of a visitor to the Allianz Arena with COVID-19, the relevant health authority can contact you in order to trace and interrupt chains of infection. As a ticket holder you are under obligation to be able to name all ticket holders (name, address, contact details).
